Great! Every room at the conference is set up with a projector and screen.

Will it work with my laptop?

Maybe? All of the projectors are equipped to take a VGA input. If your computer has a port that looks like this



you are good to go.

What if my laptop has something different?

In this case, you'll need to purchase an adaptor for yourself, like an HDMI to VGA adaptor for some newer PCs, or a Mini-DisplayPort to VGA adaptor for current Macs.
